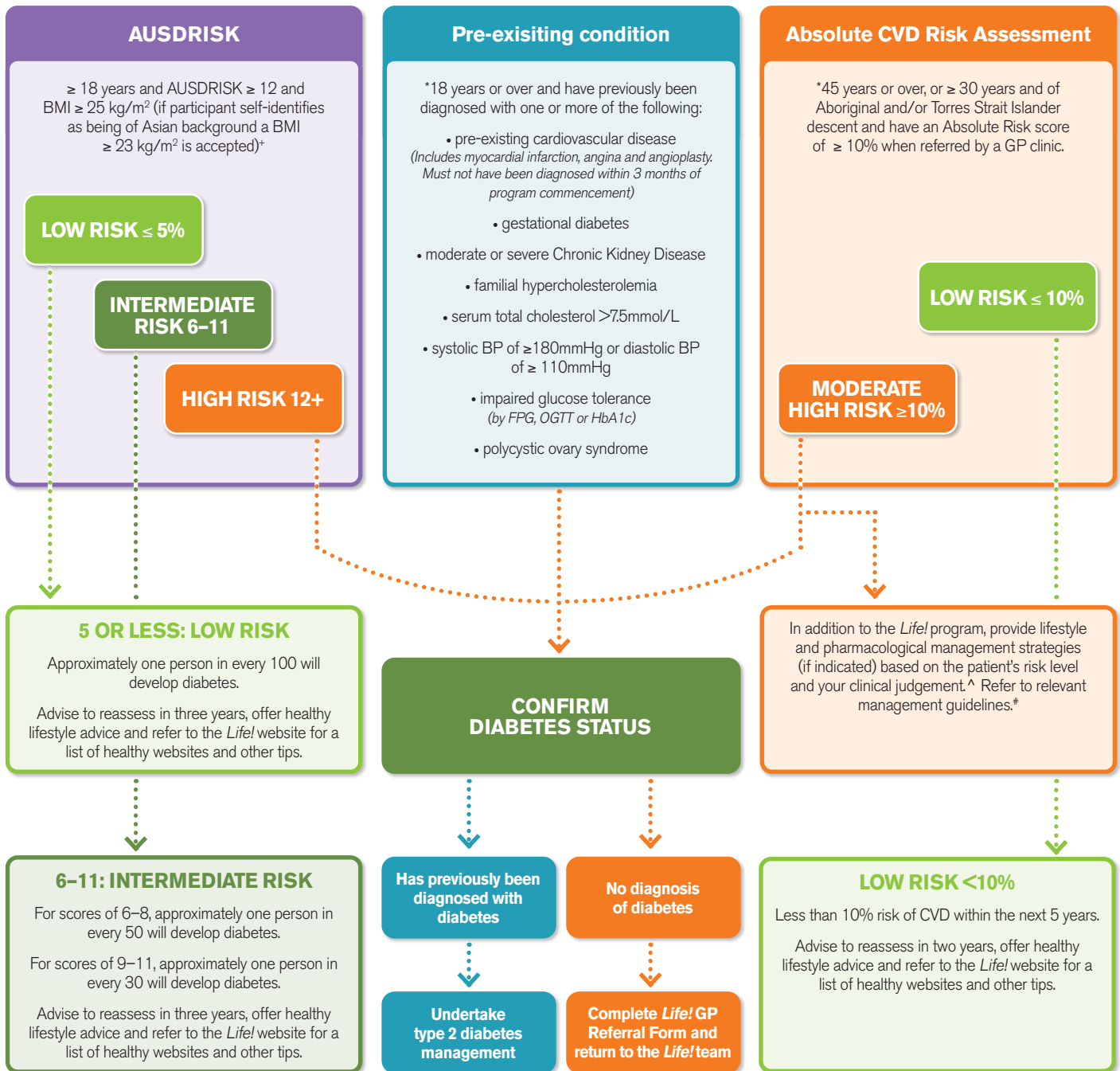


PATIENT ELIGIBILITY AND REFERRAL PATHWAY

The patient must fit at least one of the following criteria to be eligible for the *Life!* program:
